

## Approved Food Handler Training Providers for Utah County

The Utah County Health Department only accepts food handler cards or certificates from providers approved by the State. If you take a course from a provider not on the approved list, it will not be accepted. After you complete the approved course and pass the exam, the Utah County Health Department will mail the food handler permit to the applicant. Please allow at least 30 days for processing.
